ACC GUIDELINES: Please note that all applications for ACC must be submitted by the Tuesday before the Thursday meeting in order to be on the agenda. Projects should not be started before approval is received.

ALL Outside Aesthetic Changes to your house <u>MUST</u> be approved by the ACC including new roofs, new paint, siding, doors, etc....

As a reminder—per the LSLCA Covenants & Restrictions,

"No Signs or advertising structures of any kind may be erected or maintained on any lot" except for real estate signs or property for sale by owner signs. When a new roof, siding or other item is installed, the company is NOT allowed to place a sign in your yard advertising their services.

** With the nice weather just around the corner remember ALL TREE REMOVAL needs to be approved by the ACC.

Simply fill out the ACC form (include reason for removal)

Send in photo of tree(s) being removed, pictures of other trees present

(must have 2 in front & 2 in back) If it's a landmark tree you will

also need LSL City approval.**

PROCEDURES FOR CA BOAT LIFTS

Rental docks Only—Slips with an approved lift must pay \$825 Lift Deposit and fill out a Lift Agreement form at the Front Desk of the CA Office.

Please do <u>NOT</u> purchase a boat lift until the lift measurements can be verified to see if the lift will adequately fit inside your half of the rental slip! All boat lifts must be installed inside their half (50%) of the rental slip with adequate space allowed between the 2 boat lifts. Most lifts cannot be over 10' wide for rental slips (Measured from outside foot to outside foot).

ALL New & Used boat lifts require a 5-step approval process before they can be installed. This includes boat lifts being installed in personal docks...and CA rental docks. It is the owner's responsibility to submit the paperwork to get approval. If a boat lift is installed without a permit, the CA can demand that it be removed permanently at the owner's expense. The 5-Step Lakefront Project Approval form must be completed along with the regular application for all Lakefront projects (Including docks, lifts & seawalls).

Steps for registering a new registered boat to the lake

- 1. Take your bill of sale / title to the DMV (DOR) and have the boat and outboard motor titled to the house holder's name.
- a. Only CA member names may be on the title. TOD of a non-CA member is allowed.
- b. If you buy a boat with outboard motor from a state that does not title the outboard motor, when you go to the DMV tell them you will need the motor titled. They should be able to get all the information from your sellers' paperwork.
- 2. Call Water Patrol for a time to stop by
- 3. Bring all DMV paperwork proof of boat insurance with you to Water Patrol.
- 4. If you have not taken our lakes boating safety class, we can do that when registering your boat.
- 5. We will then give you a form showing completion of the inspection and boating safety course. You take that along with your DMV paperwork, proof of insurance and a form of payment to the CA office Monday-Friday 8am-5pm.

Boat Registration & Rental Dock Reminders:

All <u>New</u> boat owners must have completed the LSLCA Boating Safety Class before they can register any class boat with a motor for the 2024 boating season.

- CA Office- To register your boat for 2024, you must provide the following:
- Original Boat Title & Motor Title (outboard only) to prove ownership (NO COPIES)
- · Proof of insurance for Boat and Motor (outboard only)

<u>Newly obtained boats</u>, <u>Class 7 & 8 boats</u>, <u>Up-Graded Motors</u> <u>Must have</u> the completed and approved, Water Patrol Annual Verification Form.

NOTE: You MUST have all paperwork to receive your boat stickers ONLINE BOAT REGISTRATION PAYMENT -

WHEN YOU PICK UP YOUR STICKERS:

You must provide the following:

- Original Boat Title & Motor Title (outboard only) to prove ownership (NO COPIES)
- · Proof of insurance for Boat and Motor (outboard only)

NOTE: You MUST have all paperwork to receive your boat stickers

<u>After April 1st—If Paid Online</u>

You may pick up your 2024 REGISTRATION STICKERS @ the Water Patrol Office (located at the Main Marina)

- If not yet paid visit CA Office with All documentation.

**NOTE: Please allow 3 business days after you submit your online payment.

Boats that are on or above the water MUST have the current year's registration stickers displayed **by April 1**sr. Failure to display current year's stickers will result in a \$100 fine. Failure to display by May 1st (and subsequent months) will result in a 30-day suspension each time.

If you are out of town or unable to put your stickers on your boat please contact Water Patrol @ 636-625-3120 to make arrangements and avoid a fine.

LSLCA DOCK RENTAL FEES ARE DUE APRIL 1ST

The 2024 registration fee for the boat to be docked at your LSLCA Rental Slip must be paid before or when you pay your 2024 Dock Rental Fee (per your dock agreement).

If you have not paid your LSLCA dock rental fee by **April 1**st you have **forfeited your right to that slip and the slip will be offered to the next person on the waiting list**.

There are no exceptions.

(see Lakes & Parks Rules & Regulations, page 9, section 16).

If you are out of town, you can pay your dock rental fee online or contact the office to make your payment prior to April 1st.
